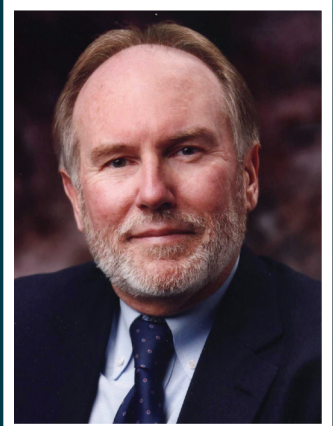


Share Your Voice with PAMED and Get Answers to Your Questions
